



GROUP AND PRIVATE VISITS

Dr Jenner's House, Museum and Garden is the beautiful Georgian house where Edward Jenner pioneered vaccination, a discovery which has saved countless lives. We welcome group and private visits throughout the year.

So that you have the best possible experience, and to take advantage of our special rates, we do ask that groups of 10 or more book in advance. Visits can be made at any time, although different minimum fees apply outside of public opening hours (usually Sundays to Wednesdays from April to October, however please see jennermuseum.com/visit for this year's times). All visits include free entry for your coach driver and a complementary familiarisation visit for group organisers by prior arrangement.

Visit options during public opening hours

Standard visit £4.25 per person (minimum cost £42.50)

Your group will gather in the Old Cyder House to be welcomed by a member of the museum team before watching our 25-minute introductory film *Jenner's Marvellous Medicine*, presented by Professor Mark Horton. We will then accompany you to the main house where you will be free to explore the collection and gardens at your leisure.

To ensure the best experience, and comply with Health & Safety regulations, groups larger than 45 will watch the film at different times and groups over 20 may be split to visit the house and gardens.

Visit with introductory talk £6.50 per person (minimum cost £65, maximum 45 visitors)

Enjoy an expert 30-minute introduction to Edward Jenner's life and legacy with a member of the museum team in the Old Cyder House, before exploring the great man's house at your own pace.

As above, to ensure you have the best experience, and comply with Health & Safety regulations, groups over 20 may be split to visit the house and gardens.

Freeflow visit £4.25 per person (minimum cost £42.50, maximum 20 visitors)

Ideal for smaller groups planning to visit both Dr Jenner's House and Berkeley Castle, our freeflow visits allow your group the freedom to arrive at Dr Jenner's House when they choose. All we ask is that the group organiser collects and pays for tickets for the whole group upon arrival in Berkeley.

Visit options outside of public opening hours

Standard visit £4.25 per person (minimum cost £75)

Your group will gather in the Old Cyder House to be welcomed by a member of the museum team before watching our 25-minute introductory film *Jenner's Marvellous Medicine*, presented by Professor Mark Horton. We will then accompany you to the main house, opened just for your group, where you will be free to explore the collection and gardens at your leisure.

Please note that to ensure the best experience, and comply with Health & Safety regulations, groups larger than 45 will have to watch the introductory film at different times and groups over 20 may be split to visit the house and gardens.

Visit with introductory talk £6.50 per person (minimum cost £75, maximum 45 visitors)

Enjoy an expert 30-minute introduction to Edward Jenner's life and legacy with a member of the museum team in the Old Cyder House, before exploring the great man's house, opened just for your group, at your own pace.

As above, to ensure you have the best experience, and comply with Health & Safety regulations, groups over 20 may be split to visit the house and gardens.

Refreshments

We can provide your group with light refreshments, which must be booked in advance for the whole group. Refreshments will be served in the Old Cyder House. For your comfort, groups of 25 or over may wish to divide into two or more sittings.

Please note that we do not have a café at the museum; groups not ordering refreshments in advance will be able to use our picnic spaces but will not be able to purchase food on the day.

Additional options

Expert talk £100 for the group, plus admission charge as above (maximum 45 visitors)

Join one of our expert speakers for a private talk, tailored wherever possible to suit your group's interests. Some of our speakers have carried out extensive research on Edward Jenner's life, whilst others have many years' practical experience on the frontline of vaccination and immunology today.

Room hire available by prior arrangement

Sometimes groups wish to use one of our rooms for a meeting, or for their own speaker. We are more than happy to accommodate this, subject to availability, but we will need to make a charge for this according to our venue hire tariff. Please email info@edwardjenner.co.uk for details.

Practicalities

Access

We welcome visitors with access needs but for group visits it is very helpful for us to know in advance of any requirements so that we can help ensure all visitors have the best possible experience. A copy of our Access Statement can be sent on request or downloaded from our website. Group organisers should note that there is no step-free access to the room usually used for talks and the introductory film. Alternative arrangements can however be made with prior notice.

Transport and parking

For groups arriving in their own cars, we can accommodate up to 10 cars in our free car park at the front of the museum. There is further free parking available in nearby town centre car parks.

There is no coach access to the museum due to width and weight restrictions on High Street and Church Lane. We ask that groups arriving by coach are dropped off and collected at the Berkeley Arms Hotel on Canonbury Street. Parking for coaches is available by arrangement at Berkeley Castle.

If you are combining a visit to Dr Jenner's House with one to Berkeley Castle, you can park at Berkeley Castle and take the 5-minute walk through the churchyard to the museum. Please note that as we are independent of Berkeley Castle, you will need to arrange your visit there via the Castle Administrator.

Booking process

Once you have completed an enquiry form we will confirm receipt and a provisional reservation. We will then issue an invoice for a deposit payment of £30. All visits are provisional until the deposit is received; this must be by one month prior to the visit date. The deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. We ask you to notify us of any changes in numbers two weeks prior to your visit, after which no changes can be made. The final balance will be payable before, or on, the day of your visit.
